PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Worcester Recovery Center and Hospital houses 320 patient beds. The building's design features patient-community integration through house, neighborhood, and downtown concepts. Arden designed and installed a complete sprinkler system to protect people and property in the event of a fire. The project also included the abatement and demolition of 15 buildings, as well as the construction of a new boiler plant and other ancillary buildings, to support the adjacent Department of Mental Health and University of Massachusetts research facilities.
